

I need you to elect these Democratic judges to stop dangerous legislation from becoming law and stand up for the rights of every Pennsylvanian.



The Register of Wills division is responsible for filing all papers in reference to the probate of wills and estates and all related documents. The primary goal of the office is to serve all county residents, especially in times of grieving.



The Recorder of Deeds division records all documents pertaining to land and property transactions including deeds, mortgages, leases, liens, surveys, financing statements and rights of way.



Additionally, the office keeps records of oaths of office for all county elected officials, notary publics, district justices, military discharges, and highway maps.

Copies of all documents are maintained and preserved for public use. Lawyers, title searchers, loan officers, and genealogists are among those who frequently research records, which date back to 1771. (www.bedfordcountyregisterrecorder.com)

# WHY YOUR VOTE MATTERS ON NOVEMBER 7th

Republicans have controlled the State Legislature since 2010. This is what we got.

- Once again, the Legislature is unable to complete the budgeting process. This makes two out of the last three years that Pennsylvania's Legislature is unable to do its job and pass an on-time budget. We pay extra because school districts and county governments have to borrow money to operate.
- This is the same group that passed a voter identification law that made it harder for people who don't have driver's licenses to vote. The courts ruled the law unconstitutional.
- The Republican legislature drew congressional boundaries so that Republicans control 13 of the 18 congressional seats, even though they are 38% of the registered voters in PA.
- The U.S Congress is unable to accomplish anything even though they control all of the power.

#### Democrats have allowed this to happen!

Since 2010, Republican voter turnout has been greater than Democrat turnout in each election. The difference has been as high as 9%. You can turn this around by voting! Pennsylvania Democrats outnumber Republicans in registered voters by over 800,000.


